**\*\*NOTICE:** No animals will be accepted onto the Show Grounds unless they are registered with NLIS Identification Ear Tags. Waybills must be provided to the Stewards.\*\*

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- These general conditions and rules form part of the conditions of entry to the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Show. Refer General Conditions of Entry & Show Rules.
- All Breeds are covered by one set of class numbers and will be judged together. Exhibitors to state clearly the breed on the Entry Form.
- All entries must be registered with their respective breed association.
- In each case where registered stock is exhibited, the Exhibitor must produce certificate of registration as proof of age before Judging.
- Certified young stock's age to count from first day of May. No calf under six (6) months old will be eligible for judging.
- The Showgrounds is a Class 1 Area and only cattle free from brucellosis can be exhibited. All dairy cattle exhibited must be either from an accredited free herd or EBL tested within six (6) months prior to the show. Exhibitors must provide a copy of the EBL certificate with the entry form. JBAS Declaration to be completed with movement record.
- Stewards in the Dairy Cattle Section have absolute control of stalls and the appointment of Exhibitors to them.
- All animals must be entered "Free from Disease or Ticks".
- All dairy cattle must be led up to the Judge for judging.
- All competitors must remain in the Dairy judging area until ALL judging is complete.
- When returning to the sheds, please exit behind the Stud Beef Cattle ring. Please consider the competitors' still competing in the ring.
- It is hereby expressly stated that the Society declines any responsibility in connection with bulls over eighteen (18) months, or damage by them. The Owner shall be responsible and each bull shall be accompanied by a responsible person. Only lead pole and ring is considered safe, and no other method of leading is allowed.
- All exhibitors are requested to participate in the Grand Parade with their stock. Failure to do so may result in exhibitors forfeiting any prize monies.
- Pens & Groups - all cattle must be owned by the Exhibitor.
- Partnerships must be registered at least three (3) months prior to the show.
- Exhibitor's Passes will be issued on receipt of Entry Form. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to collect passes. Passes: 1 animal = 1 pass; 2 or 3 animals = 2 passes; 4 or more animals = 3 passes.
- Vehicles & trailers transporting dairy cattle will be allowed to enter the grounds to unload. Immediately on unloading the vehicle &/or trailer must be removed from the ground.
- For use on waybills, the PIC No for the Atherton Showgrounds is QIAE0505

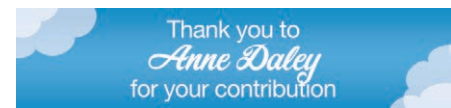
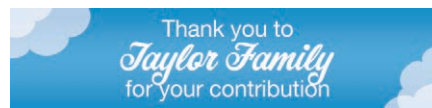
