- Animals will be supplied for all classes.
- All entrants are to be 18 years or under at the date of show.

- All entrants in handling and judging classes will wear appropriate neat clothes and covered shoes. White coats are optional and are available for loan from the Goat Stewards.
- No Late entries will be accepted.

JUNIOR JUDGING

Sponsors: Goat Club

1. Junior Judge – grade 9 and under
2. Junior Judge – grade 10 - 12

CRITERIA:

- Junior Judging entrants will rank each goat using criteria such as structure, teeth and conformation.
- The winning competitor will place them in the same order or closest to the judge's.
- Entrants will be expected to clearly and briefly explain why exhibits were placed in a particular order.
- Junior Judges will judge 3 animals from commercial meat goats.
- Junior Judges will judge 3 animals from Dairy Goats.

Judging entrants will judge all classes of animals including:

COMMERCIAL MEAT GOATS

- Buck, any age, registered or not registered
- Junior Doe - 2 tooth and under
- Senior Doe - more than 2 tooth
- Potential Carcass Under 25kg Live Weight
- Potential Carcass Over 25kg Live Weight

DAIRY GOATS

- Any breed under 12 months
- Any breed 12 months-2 years
- Any breed over 2 years
- Buck, any age, registered or not registered

JUNIOR HANDLING

Judged on presentation, handling ability, ring craft & knowledge of animal shown.

4. Junior Handler – grades 4 – 6
5. Junior Handler – grades 7 - 9
6. Junior Handler – grades 10 - 12

JUNIOR GOAT PRESENTATION

7. Junior Best Groomed & Presented Goat
Open ages 8-18 years

Fancy Dress: Handlers may also be in fancy dress. No hair-dyes or glitter to be used on goats. Any goat fancy dress judged to put the goats welfare at risk will be disqualified.
