NOTES ON PRESENTATION:

- Stalks are to be at least 2-3cm long
- Roots are to be trimmed, but must be at least 3cm long
- Root vegetables are to be presented with plant tops intact and untrimmed
- Samples should be clean and insect-free, and may be tidied up before presentation (remove dead leaves, etc)
- Rubber bands may be used for bundling and gathering if required
- If a sample does not comply with the sample size or the requirements for presentation, it may be deemed NAS (Not According to Schedule) and will not be judged.
- Where a sample size is not specified, use the Standard Units as noted here.

STANDARD UNITS: Very Large: One; Large: Three; Medium: Five; Small: Ten.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Refer General Conditions of Entry & Show Rules.
- Class Cards are to be clearly displayed on the exhibits.
- Judges may cut samples at their discretion for the purpose of judging.
- A new class may be created if there are exhibits of the same type entered by three (3) or more different exhibitors.
- Unless stewards are notified when entering, exhibits will become the property of the Society.
- A specialised Agriculture Entry Form is available or entries may be made on the General Entry Form provided.
- Entries are limited to four (4) per exhibitor per class.
- Junior exhibitors must be under 18 years at time of Show.
