CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Refer General Conditions of Entry & Show Rules.
- All exhibits, except pot plants, entered in this section immediately become the property of the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Show Society and are not available for collection by exhibitors after the Show.
- Class Cards are to be clearly displayed on the front of exhibits.
- Ornamental vases, pots, bowls, etc are the responsibility of the Exhibitor.
- Jars and water will be provided by the Society.
- Exhibits that do not match a Class will be accepted at the discretion of the Steward.
- A specialised Floriculture Entry Form is available but entries may be made on the General Entry Form.
- Entries are limited to eight (8) per exhibitor per class.
- Only Show officials will be allowed on the display area of Merriland Hall after 10am Sunday prior to the show.
- Stewards are available on Saturday prior to the show.
- All exhibits are to be presented to the Stewards at the steps.
- All pots and baskets must be clean and no exhibit will be accepted if the pot diameter is over 25cm (10"). Plastic pots preferred.
- Pot Plants must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor 3 months prior to Show.
- All exhibits in Cut Flowers are to be grown by Exhibitor, not purchased or wild harvested.
