*No animals will be accepted onto the Show Grounds unless they are registered with NLIS Identification Ear Tags. Waybills must be provided to the Stewards. \*\**

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- These general conditions and rules form part of the conditions of entry to the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Show. Refer General Conditions of Entry & Show Rules.
- All cattle must be of a quiet nature and able to be led.
- Exhibitors shall not, under any circumstances, bring onto the Showgrounds any animal, which has, or by reason of association may have, any notifiable or dangerous disease.
- The Society declines any responsibility in connection with the animals or injury to or by them. The Owner shall be personally responsible.
- All animals must be entered "Free from Disease or Ticks".
- Vehicles & Trailers transporting cattle for this section will be allowed to enter the grounds to unload. Immediately on unloading the Vehicle &/or trailer must be removed from the grounds.
- Exhibitor's Passes will be issued on receipt of Entry Form and must be collected by the Exhibitor.
- Passes: 1 animal = 1 pass; 2 or 3 animals = 2 passes; ≥4 = 3 passes.
- Breed must be shown on Entry Form.
- All animals must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor, and must be fully registered with respective Breed Societies. Certificate of Registration must be available for inspection. Registrations will be checked with respective Breed Societies.
- Supreme Champions and Groups will be Inter-breed competitions.
- Age of registered animals is to be calculated from birth to 1st July this year.
- All animals 12 months & over to be dogged or ringed with lead attached when handled on the grounds. For safety reasons neck straps are preferred by the Society.
- Stud Cattle to be led out in age order - eldest to youngest. Entry Form to have date of birth for ease of organising age position.
- Any calf shown on a cow is not eligible to be shown in age classes.
- Please include all calves on the entry form, even if they are on a cow.
- Maximum age for a calf shown on a cow is nine (9) months.
- No cattle are allowed as non-competitive.
- Bedding - Society will supply initial bedding only.
- All exhibitors are requested to participate in the Grand Parade with their stock and failure to do so may result in exhibitors forfeiting any prize monies.
- For use on waybills, the PIC No for the Atherton Showgrounds is QIAE0505
- In the event that there is less than 3 competitors in any 1 class, at the discretion of the judge or stewards, classes may be combined.
- Camping on grounds: Forms must be submitted along with entry forms and fees on or before Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July. Site will be allocated upon application and payment. Cost for camp site fees start at \$15.
- Stewards reserve the right to refuse any vehicles/camping equipment they deem excessive.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Refer General Conditions of Entry & Show Rules in back of Schedule.
- Competitors judge one class of four animals.
- Animals in each class will be identified by numbers 1 to 4.
- All competitors will take part in oral judging.
- Visual judging will take place first. Competitors will be allowed 8 minutes to judge the four animals and to complete each judging.
- Each competitor in the oral class is allowed 3 minutes for ring craft and speaking.
- Competitors in the oral class are scored on their ringcraft, accuracy of observation, their comparative statements, speaking ability and general personation and dress.
- Age as at 1st May 2018
- The Winner of Young Judges Competition will only be eligible to compete in the Far North Qld Finals being held at Tully Show.
- If you believe you are eligible to participate in the North Queensland Sub-Chamber or Queensland Chamber competitions, please contact the Atherton Show Society office.

### **Camping Sites**

- A limited number of camping sites are available, with preference given to travelling exhibitors.
- Applications must be made on the correct form and paid in advance.
- Please indicate your vehicle size on the form. (Space is limited so please ensure your vehicle /camping equipment is not excessive. Stewards reserve the right to refuse camping to any vehicle/camping equipment they deem excessive)
- Sites will be allocated as exhibitors arrive on the day, and the Atherton Show Society will have the final decision on site allocation.
- The fee covers two nights. Extra nights available.

### **Terms of Application**

- No vehicles are allowed movement on the showgrounds during Show Days; between 10am and 10pm on Monday, and 9am and 4pm on Tuesday. Please arrange to deliver any feed or other supplies outside of these hours.
- Applicants/Exhibitors must agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and acknowledge that any misconduct or refusal to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the immediate removal of the applicant/exhibitor and their horse(s) no matter where that may occur.
- By signing this application you are agreeing to indemnify the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Society Inc, against Liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness caused to anyone, including but not limited to the applicant/exhibitor or their property, or a member of the public during any part of the event, including but not limited to stabling, camping, preparation, competition, judging, performing or displaying.

### **Gate Passes**

- All persons occupying a camp site must pre-purchase their passes on this Application Form.
- Prices for 2-day gate passes are Adults \$20 and Children/Pensioners \$10.
